WMH has approximately 450 hospital inpatient admissions per year, 150 swing bed admissions per year, and 650 observation days per year yielding an average daily census of 11.

Community Medical Associates of Washington and Lincolnton opened in 2010 and are both hospital-owned and operated Rural Health Clinics. CMA Lincolnton clinic care is provided by a Family Medicine physician and an FNP. CMA Washington Clinic care is provided by an Internal Medicine/Pediatric physician, a Family Medicine physician, a full time PA, and a part time NP. Combined CMA Clinics have over 15,000 visits per year.
